Request for Additional Semester of TCU Funded Scholarships and Financial Aid

Money relinquished by graduating seniors provides funding for scholarships and grants for the next entering class. Consequently, the result of extending an award for a student who has exhausted their eligibility could result in a reduction of funding for a new student entering the university during that time period. Therefore, all requests for extensions are **subject to the availability of funds after awards are made for new students, and after all aid has been renewed for eligible returning students.**

One additional semester is typically provided for BME students since that program requires more than 124 credit hours for graduation. However, extra time needed for this program as well as all other music degrees and situations requires submission of this form, as do requests for any further semester extensions.
